



Underbank Primary Home Learning – Primary 1



Topic: Read or listen to a Katie Morag story. Talk to your family about what happened. Explain what was your favourite part.	Science: Explain to your family different items in your house that use water. Think of some good ways that we can save water.	Healthy: Design or create an obstacle course in your garden. How fast can you complete it?	Healthy: Challenge yourself to see how many star jumps you can do in one minutes. Do it again and try to beat your old score.
Literacy: Build a reading den. Find somewhere cosy snuggle up and read your favourite book.	Active: Keep moving. Make up a dance to your favourite song.	Nurtured: Show your family some of the mindfulness breathing we do in class. If you have any colouring books you could do some mindfulness colouring as well.	Numeracy: Practice your days of the week and months of the year. Get an adult to name a month and see if you can name the one before and after.
Achieving: Help your family weigh out different ingredients to make cakes or to prepare dinner. Make a list of what was needed and how much was used.	Achieving: List Making - Make a list of all the things that make you happy and all the things that you are good at.	Numeracy: Count up to and back from 20. Ask someone to choose a number and then give them the number before and after. Write numbers onto scraps of paper, put in numeral order, remove one, what is missing number.	Literacy: List different words that begin with your initial sounds a-z, and words that begin with the double sound 'wh'. Try writing some of your words in a sentence or story.
Technology. Use different materials from your house to create a junk model of your choice.	Numeracy: Use different house materials, objects or colouring pens to make a pattern at home. Think about using different shapes and colours.	Science: Create your own feely bag, such as an old rucksack, with items in from around the house. Use a bag that isn't see through. This is a wonderful opportunity for children to explore their senses.	Literacy: Practice forming your letters the correct way. This should be the small and capital letter format.
