



Underbank Primary Home Learning – Primary 6/7



Topic: Interview a parent or sibling about their thoughts on the situation and write a newspaper report on it. Think of a catchy headline.	Healthy: Talk about transition to your new class or to High School with a parent. What will you need to think about? Lunches, bag organisation, timetables. Talk about any concerns you may have.	Safe: Choreograph a dance to your favourite music - perform for your family or get them involved in the dancing.	Safe Create a recipe for a dinner with the foods you already have in the house or research a recipe with the ingredients you have.
Literacy: Write a persuasive letter on a subject you feel strongly about e.g. logging in the Amazon, equity in football. Remember to use the persuasive techniques and emotive language.	Active: How many burpees can you do in one minute? See if you can beat your personal best. Challenge a family member to do the same!	Nurtured: Offer a massage to one of your family members using the massage techniques we use in school e.g. the skater, brushing the horse etc. Remember to ask for permission!	Numeracy: Conduct a survey about the amount of technology at home e.g. mobile phones, ipads, kindles, lap tops etc. You could draw a bar graph to display the information - remember to label the graph. Which device is the most popular? How many computers are owned all together? Which computer is the least popular? Put the results in order from least popular to most popular. What is the difference between the least and the most popular?
Achieving: Create a game for any subject area to play with your family. It could be a game you play with counters and a board or a game without resources e.g. Tig, Buzz	Achieving: Create your family tree in French. e.g. ma mere s'appelle, Julie	Numeracy: Play Buzz or even Buzz Fizz Whizz if you want to test your parents out with their times tables. Remember to say buzz for the stations of the times table.	Literacy: Write a Haiku on a subject matter of your choice e.g. friendships, family,
Active: Create a chores rota with your parents.	Numeracy: Area Calculate the area of some of the rooms in your house - remember to use the formula $A=L \times B$. Then google carpet prices. Calculate the cost of new carpets for the rooms you have measured.	Included: Create a short drama with a sibling or parent. Could be made up or from your favourite show/movie.	Literacy: Note the punctuation used in the texts you have been reading. How does it affect the writing? E.g. colons for emphasis, semi-colons in listing.
