Who does it go with? What happens when it is there?</p>
<p>Science:</p> <p>Around the house, use your senses to find an object that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • smells nice • is yellow • feels smooth • tastes salty • sounds squeaky 	<p>Maths:</p> <p>Hide a toy in a room. Can you direct a special person to your toy using your left and right vocabulary?</p> <p>E.g. turn left, take 5 steps forward, turn right, take two steps forwards.</p>	<p>Numeracy:</p> <p>Practise your number bonds to 20 and use them to help your quick recall of addition and subtraction facts, i.e.</p> <p>0 + 20 = 20 1 + 19 = 20 2 + 18 = 20</p> <p>20 - 17 = 3 20 - 16 = 4 20 - 15 = 5</p>	<p>Literacy:</p> <p>Practise learning and writing the different common words that are listed below.</p> <p>Write sentences with these to challenge yourself.</p> <p>little, one, first, had, see, has, play, no, look</p>
<p>Topic:</p> <p>Think about the changes we see happen in spring, summer, autumn and winter.</p> <p>Draw 4 pictures, one for each season and compare the differences.</p>	<p>Numeracy:</p> <p>Access Education City using the login provided.</p> <p>There are games set for you to play.</p>	<p>Included:</p> <p>Help an adult with household chores.</p> <p>For example, you could tidy your room or help set the table.</p>	<p>Literacy:</p> <p>Explore the following new sounds;</p> <p>'oo' 'ee' 'ph'</p> <p>Brainstorm different words that have these sounds in them. .</p>
