<p><u>Literacy - Research</u></p> <p>Who is the Patron Saint of Scotland? Record some facts about him. You could use the facts to make a mind map.</p>	<p><u>Social Studies</u></p> <p>Look at a map of Scotland. Find your town or village. Can you now find out the names of some rivers in Scotland?</p>	<p><u>Technology/Expressive Arts</u></p> <p>Check to see if your surname has a Scottish clan tartan. Can you recreate your tartan using the colours needed? If you don't have a tartan then why not create one for your family.</p>
<p><u>Numeracy</u></p> <p>If I were to give you £10, could you find a lovely Scottish gift to send to a friend or relative abroad? How much did it cost? What coins did you use to pay for it? Did you get any change?</p>	<p><u>Expressive Arts</u></p> <p>Go for a walk and try to find a thistle. Look carefully or take a photo. When you get home, try to create a pencil drawing of a thistle._</p>	<p><u>Social Studies</u></p> <p>There are many mountains in Scotland. Which one is the highest? Find out how high it is. Which towns and villages might you be able to see from the top?</p>
<p><u>Health and Wellbeing</u></p> <p>Find the largest wellington boot in your house. Have a go at the welly toss. Measure in footsteps or metres how long each throw is.</p>	<p><u>Expressive Arts</u></p> <p>Research a Scottish artist. Where are they from? What makes their art special or unique? Have a go at recreating a piece of their work.</p>	<p><u>Food Technology</u></p> <p>Work with someone else, follow a recipe and make some shortbread or another Scottish food. Ask someone at home to do a food review by detailing what they liked about the dish.</p>
<p><u>Outdoor Learning</u></p> <p>Create the Loch Ness Monster in your garden using materials you find in and around your house and garden.</p>	<p><u>Expressive Arts</u></p> <p>Learn a traditional Scottish song or rhyme or a song written about Scotland.</p> <p>Could you perform this for someone you know?</p>	<p><u>Literacy</u></p> <p>Scottish Words - Ask people in your house to tell you some Scottish words. We call this 'Scots Language'. Make little flashcards for each of the words that have been shared with you e.g. wean, bahookie, neb. Share your flashcards with others in your house.</p>
