We were lucky enough to have Fischy Music back in school again yesterday. Fischy Music is a Scottish charity founded in 1998 by Stephen Fischbacher. They create songs to nurture positive mental health in children by helping them express and manage a range of emotions. Our children thoroughly their morning workshops and sharing their learning with the parents and family members who managed along to the showcase.

We gained funding for the visit and for access to their online musical activities via a successful bid to Scottish Mental Health Arts Festival 2023 (SMHAF). Staff are excited to have these resources available to us for the year ahead.
