Rural Ace Courses for Parents

The Rural Academy is offering the following free Courses in January 2024.

<u>The Education Support Assistant course</u>: The ESA course is free and available anyone over 16 year of age, who has officially left school and who are looking to work in the education sector in the Clydesdale area. The course duration is 6 months - January 2024 to June 2024. 3 days per week - 2 days in the classroom (tbc) and 1 day on placement (tbc) in a local school, while the other 2 days are for self-study at home.

The course is designed to be taught during school hours (9.15/9.30am - 2.45pm). The modules you will learn will include Play in Early Education and Childcare, Supporting Language, Literacy and Numeracy in an Educational Setting, and Supporting Children & Young People who require Additional Support Needs, are designed to get you ready to assist teaching in a class at all levels of education -Nursery, Primary and High School, as well as ASN Schools and classes.

As the college works in partnership with South Lanarkshire Council, they will guarantee those who have submitted a successful application an interview with the SLC, for a post as an Education Support Assistant.

On completion and successful achievement of the 6-month course, you will gain the Personal Development Award in Education Support Assistance.

The NPA in Admin Services and Numeracy course:

The course is 2 days per week starting w/c 22nd January (days have still to be decided). The hours are 9.15/9.30am to 2.45pm, to suit those with children at school.

The course will be based at 2 Hope Street, Lanark.

This course will include numeracy skills at a level that is suitable for you.

The other units include:

Front of Office Skills.

Practical Office Skills and Technologies. Researching and Preparing Presentations. Budgeting Skills.

Employability support i.e., help with updating your CV.

Self-Study (including some homework).

Reminders

After School Arrangements

School Meal Debt on ParentPay

Just a gentle reminder to P6 and P7 parents. Please keep your child's school meals account in credit. We have a number of outstanding balances. Please pop onto ParentPay and clear any outstanding debtor balances. If you wish to discuss this then please contact us.

Dogs on School Grounds

Just a little reminder that dogs are not permitted in any area of our school grounds, this includes the carpark area. Thank you for your co-operation on this matter.

Covid Reminder

Although there is no longer a requirement to do a Lateral Flow Test, there is still the need to be vigilant and continue with good hygiene.

Children who are unwell and have a high temperature should stay at home and avoid contact with other people, where they can. They can come back to school, and resume normal activities when they no longer have a high temperature and are well enough to attend.

Uniform and Belongings

Children should wear their school uniform and should wear jackets and footwear that are suitable for playing and learning outdoors. Children will change into indoor shoes on entering the building each day. If going outdoors for PE, then our children will wear the outdoor shoes they are wearing to school on their PE davs.
