## Underbank Primary Update 10 – 26th January 2024



#### **P1 Enrolment**

We have had seven August P1 enrolments via South Lanarkshire Council's online enrolment system. We have also had a number of placing requests submitted, all of which will be considered by South Lanarkshire Council in due course. I have invited the parents of our new August P1 children to visit the school for a short tour of the school and we look forward to welcoming them into our school community.

Thanks to all parents who have requested seats for our Scottish Celebration. Seat requests were due in no later than today. Our hall is now very close to being at full capacity and unfortunately, we cannot accept people turning up 'on the day', so please, if you haven't requested a seat, please do so as a matter of urgency.

No tickets will be issued this year. On entering the school, family names will be scored off our attendance sheet.

Doors will open at 10am and the celebration will start promptly at 10:15am. We will have a lucky programme, for which, we are looking for a small donation. The winner of the lucky programme will receive a hamper full of Scottish goodies.

Thank you to all parents who supported and encouraged their child to learn their Scottish poem. Children can wear something tartan on this day if they wish (eg tartan ribbon, tie, dress, checked shirt). The children have all been working hard on their poems and class presentations, and they can't wait to share these with you.

#### **Homework Survey**

Thank you for your valuable responses to our homework survey. The key results from this are:

- Overwhelmingly, 81% stated that they were in favour of homework.
- Over 56% stated that the current schedule of homework was the most family friendly, but consideration will be given to all responses.
- We are continuing to consider responses to preferred homework activities as we had a

variety of answers here, however learners seem to show a preference for reading, maths worksheets and online maths activities, such as Sumdog.

We plan to further review responses during our February Inservice Day.

#### **LGS Transition Arrangements**

All P7 children transferring to Lanark Grammar in August were given a Class Grouping form yesterday to discuss with parents and to return to the school (Underbank) as soon as convenient.

Parents of our P7 pupils are also required to apply for school transport, if this is required. This can be done via the South Lanarkshire Website.

Parents making a placing request to Lanark Grammar may also apply for privilege transport. This can be done via the same process except click on the privilege transport link.

#### Toys, Cards & Football

We have asked that toys, football cards etc are left at home. This is having a positive impact on the number of disagreements between children.

We have also been trialling having no football in our MUGA. Currently we have set up an obstacle course for pupils to access on their MUGA day. Unfortunately, due to the frost and

#### **Transport Consultation**

As you know, the Council are conducting a statutory consultation on the proposal to alter the qualifying distance for free secondary school mainstream transport to those living over 3 miles from their catchment secondary school. (current entitlement is more than 2 miles).

The proposal is open to statutory public consultation until Friday 1 March 2024.

#### **After School Arrangements**

Please contact the school office before 2:30pm if your child has not to go on the school bus. We have five buses, a Playbarn minibus and a taxi to co-ordinate at 3pm and when children don't arrive to register for their bus at 2:55pm, it holds up all other buses.

Please also bear in mind when asking other parents to collect your child, that we would really appreciate if we could be notified of these arrangements. This is particularly important for our younger children.

With regards to after school clubs, if your child has signed up for an afterschool club, then we anticipate that they are staying for the club. We sometimes have children saying that they then cannot attend. Unless a parent notifies us that their child is not attending the afterschool club, then pupils who have signed up will be sent to join in.

#### **Car Park**

Please be extremely cautious when walking across our car park/ pedestrian areas during adverse weather. The ground underfoot can be very slippery. Also take care when driving into the car park as this can also become icy during cold spells.

#### **Class WhatsApp Groups**

We know that some class/stage groups have created WhatsApp Groups for parental communication. Please be mindful that by joining these groups, you are sharing your personal information (telephone number) across the group.

#### Covid Reminder

Although there is no longer a requirement to do a Lateral Flow Test, there is still the need to be vigilant and continue with good hygiene.

Children who are unwell and have a high temperature should stay at home and avoid contact with other people, where they can. They can come back to school and resume normal activities when they no longer have a high temperature and are well enough to attend.

#### **Lost Property**

We endeavour to ensure that pupils return home from school with all their belongings and can easily do this if items have a child's name on them. If we can't identity who an item belongs to, then we put it into our lost property box in our

foyer. Please feel free to pop in and check this box, if your child does misplace any items.

#### **Uniform and Belongings**

Children should wear their school uniform and should wear jackets and footwear that are suitable for playing and learning outdoors. Children will change into indoor shoes on entering the building each day. If going outdoors for PE, then our children will wear the outdoor shoes they are wearing to school on their PE days.

Please ensure all items of clothing, footwear, packed lunches, snack tubs etc. are all clearly labelled with your child's name.
